HOW TO COMMUNICATE WITH ANIMALS

DOGS

DO use short verbal commands (ex. "Sit," "down") and distinct hand signals.



DO NOT use common words, phrases, or gestures.



DOLITTLE SAYS: Speaking the commands in a language you don't normally use will help your dog differentiate the words and make them easier to learn!



BIRDS

DO pair words and phrases with visual representations.



DO NOT ignore "chatter" — It means your bird is trying and should be rewarded!



DOLITTLE SAYS: Birds love enthusiasm, so speak loudly and excitedly to them!



APES

Studies with primates (gorillas, chimpanzees, bonobos, etc.) have found that many species can memorize sign language! Some helpful signings:
